



## User Role

DCirrus Virtual Data Room platform comes with 3 types of users i.e. Partner, Admin, and User.

	<b>PARTNER</b>	<b>ADMIN</b>	<b>USER</b>
<b>Document Access</b>	Partners have full access to all Documents in VDR.	Admin has access to specific documents or folders based on the permissions granted by the Partner.	The Users typically have access to specific documents or folders based on the permissions granted by the Partner/Admin.
<b>Administrator Privileges</b>	Partner Can manage the overall settings and configuration of the virtual data room.	Admin doesn't have Administrative Privilege.	The user doesn't have Administrator Privilege.
<b>User Management</b>	Partners can add, modify, or remove users from the VDR.	Admin can add, modify, or remove users of his own and assigned user groups from the VDR.	The user doesn't have User Management Access.
<b>Access Control</b>	Partner has control over who can access certain documents, and folders within the VDR.	Admin has control over the documents or Folder that he has permission or created/uploaded within the VDR.	The User doesn't have Folder access control.
<b>Audit Trail</b>	Partners can access audit trails and activity logs to monitor user activities and ensure compliance.	Admin can access audit trails and activity logs to monitor their own group activities and assigned user groups' activity to ensure compliance.	The user doesn't have access to Audit trails.
